Day 1, Monday, January 6, 2020 - Depart USA

Depart USA on your transatlantic flight to Tel Aviv, Israel, with dinner and breakfast served en route.

Day 2, Tuesday, January 7, 2020 - Arrive in Israel, Jaffa

Arrive in Tel Aviv. Visit the old city of Jaffa, where Simon the Tanner lived and from where Peter left to bring the gospel to Cornelius (Acts 9, 10). Transfer to your hotel in Netanya for dinner and overnight.

Day 3, Wednesday, January 8, 2020 - Caesarea, Mt. Carmel, Megiddo, Mt. Precipice

Proceed northward along the coast of the Mediterranean Sea to Caesarea, a center of the early Christians, where you will visit the Roman Aqueduct and Theatre. Above the city of Haifa is Mt. Carmel, where Elijah defeated the Baal prophets. You'll visit the monastery at the top of the mountain. Travel to Megiddo (biblical Armageddon), where 20 different cities lie superimposed upon each other. Visit Mt. Precipice, where Luke describes how Jesus was rejected by those in the synagogue after He taught them. Overnight in the Galilee.

Day 4, Thursday, January 9, 2020 - Jesus Boat, Galilee Boat Ride, Arbel Cliffs, Capernaum, Mt. of Beatitudes, Peter's Primacy

Begin your morning with a visit to Nof Ginosar to see the ancient boat dating to the time of Christ. Continue with a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. View the Sea of Galilee from Mt. Arbel. Explore Capernaum, the center of Jesus' ministry in the Galilean region. Visit the synagogue, which stands on the site where Jesus taught. Recall His teaching and preaching the gospel of the kingdom. Visit the peaceful Mt. of Beatitudes. On this hill, Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount. Stop at the Chapel of the Primacy, where Peter confessed his devotion to Christ 3 times (John 21). Overnight in the Galilee.

Day 5, Friday, January 10, 2020 - Caesarea Philippi, Tel Dan, Golan Heights, Mt. Bental

This morning travel to Banias (Caesarea Philippi), where Peter confessed that Jesus was the Christ. Continue on to Tel Dan,

where you can see the ancient city gates from the time of Abraham. Enjoy a lush stroll through the beautiful nature preserve. You will continue on with a visit to the Golan Heights including Mt. Bental. Overnight in the Galilee.

Day 6, Saturday, January 11, 2020 - Qumran, Ein Gedi, Masada, Jerusalem-Mt. Scopus view


Visit Qumran to view the site where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered and the area that was inhabited by the mysterious community of the Essenes. Journey to Ein Gedi and visit the nature preserve and waterfall. Visit Masada, Herod's mountaintop fortress, which became the last stronghold of the Jewish revolt against the Romans. Ride the cable car to the top to explore. Peer down upon the remains of the Roman camps and siege ramp. Have your first view of the Old City of Jerusalem from Mt. Scopus. Overnight in the Jerusalem area.

Day 7, Sunday, January 12, 2020 - Biblical Gardens at Yad Hashmona, Ayalon Valley, Road to Emmaus, Sorek Valley, Elah Valley

Learn Biblical customs at the Yad Hashmona Biblical Gardens. Journey into the Old Testament as you visit the Valley of Ayalon, where the sun stood still as Joshua defeated the Amorites. Walk the Road to Emmaus, where Jesus met two disciples after His resurrection. See the Sorek Valley, home of Samson and Delilah. Remember David's victory over Goliath in the Valley of Elah. Overnight in the Jerusalem area.

Day 8, Monday, January 13, 2020 - Knesset, Second Temple Model, Shrine of the Book, Shepherds' Fields, Yad Vashem

View the Knesset, Israel's Parliament. Visit the Israel Museum to see the Second Temple Model of Jerusalem and the Shrine of the Book, where you can see the fragments of the Dead Sea Scrolls. Enjoy a view of the Shepherds' Fields. Visit Yad Vashem Holocaust Memorial and be touched by its poignant images. Overnight in the Jerusalem area.



Day 9, Tuesday, January 14, 2020 - Temple Mount, Pool of Bethesda, Lithostratos, Church of the Holy Sepulchre, Western Wall, Southern Steps/Davidson Center, Jewish Quarter, Temple Institute

Visit the Temple Mount to view the site of the Jewish Temple. Continue to the Pool of Bethesda, where Christ healed the lame man. Continue to the Lithostratos to see the remains of the Antonia Fortress where Pilate tried Jesus. Visit the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Touch a piece of the Temple when you pray at the Western Wall. Visit the Davidson Center and the Southern Wall Excavations including the Teaching Steps. Walk the Jewish Quarter and take time to visit the Cardo, a 2,000-year-old market with shops old and new. Visit the Temple Institute to learn of the ordinances and ceremonies of the Temple. Overnight in Jerusalem.

Day 10, Wednesday, January 15, 2020 - Mt. of Olives, Dominus Flevit, Garden of Gethsemane, Caiaphas' House, David's Tomb, Upper Room, Garden Tomb

Recount the final hours of Jesus before His crucifixion by walking from the top of the Mt. of Olives down to the Garden of Gethsemane where He prayed and was apprehended. At Dominus Flevit Church, visit the place where Jesus mourned for Jerusalem. See the house of the High Priest Caiaphas, where Christ was imprisoned and Peter denied Him. See David's Tomb nearby. On Mt. Zion, see the Upper Room where Jesus had a final meal with his disciples. Finally, visit the Garden Tomb, where Christ was buried and see the empty tomb because He is arisen! Transfer to the Tel Aviv airport for your flight home.
